WOOLWORTHS GSA CHECKLIST

Woolworths have worked with the AFGC to develop a Woolworths specific version of the Grocery Supply Agreement (GSA) Checklist for members. The checklist aims to assist Woolworths' vendors' review and prepare for new GSA.

Background

Woolworths issued to their vendors a **Variation Deed – Trading Terms for the supply of Goods to the Australian Food Stores**. The Australian Food Stores are Woolworth's Australian Supermarkets, small stores and Thomas Dux.

Working with the AFGC to develop the Woolworths GSA Checklist provides further clarity on the Food and Grocery Code of Conduct (FGCC) obligations against the Woolworths Variation Deed.

Please note Woolworths' assurance that *'all suppliers are free to propose variations to the revised terms which we have proposed and we are always pleased to consider such requests.'*
